Dear Summerkids Parents (and former parents):

We hope everyone had a good Fourth of July holiday.

As promised, we are writing to share an update with our camp community following the recent tragedy at Summerkids.

First, we would like to thank you for the emails, phone calls, notes, food and flowers that many of you have sent in recent days. We are passing along your messages to the family of the young camper, who of course continues to be in our thoughts and prayers. Your generosity and kind wishes are greatly appreciated by all of us.

Our week began with two parent meetings, attended by nearly 150 of you. We believe these were informative sessions that helped address a variety of concerns, and we thank everyone who attended. In addition, Dr. Jennifer Levin, our traumatic grief therapist, has been available over the course of the week and will continue to help campers and parents process the recent tragedy in a healthy and supported manner. We have been told by authorities that it may take 6-8 months for their investigations to be fully completed.

Meanwhile, a sense of routine has begun returning to camp, aided by our wonderful counselors. Campers are enthusiastically participating in archery, lanyards, fort building, water games and more.

As you may know, our pool has been closed while we have reviewed our swimming policies. After careful consideration, **we have decided to re-open our pool next week with some adjustments to our swim procedures**, especially for the least experienced Summerkids campers.

For SK-PreK, we will continue our swimming program with one-on-one lessons with Water Safety Instructors that is geared toward teaching campers to be water-safe.
