- 4. I continued to check pH until I reached 6.5 ppm

INFORMATION RE THE CONTAMINATION INCIDENT

On the morning of June 28, 2019, the pool at The Angelus Mountain Center/ Summerkids levels had been checked at 7:30 a.m. The chlorine level at that time was 2.6 and no chlorine was added. The ph level was 7.5. The temperature was 82 degrees.

At the time of the accident (9:38 a. m.) there were 30 swimmers in the pool, monitored by 4 American Red Cross certified lifeguards.

Camper X (a 6-year-old girl) was observed floating facedown in the shallow end of the pool. A lifeguard immediately pulled her out and began CPR while another called 911. Paramedics arrived and transported Camper X who was still alive from the scene.

There was no stool, vomit or blood in the pool as a result of the accident.

The pool has not been used since the accident.
