**Narrative History Text:** 

Squad 11 arrived onscene first to find the patient, a 6 year old female, supine on the ground next to a pool. The patient was wet from swimming, pulseless, apneic, cyanotic with fixed and dilated pupils and copious vomitus in the mouth, on her face and on the ground next to her head. CARE ambulance personnel arrived onscene prior to Squad 11's arrival and took over CPR from local lifeguards who were performing CPR. CARE ambulance personnel had applied an AED with no shock advised just as Squad 11 personnel were running up to the scene. Squad 11 personnel directed the CARE ambulance EMT's to continue high-quality continuous chest compressions. Squad 11 personnel immediately suctioned the patient and cleared the airway as best as possible and applied an appropriately child sized OP airway (with no gag reflex). A 15mm Pink IO needle was inserted into the left proximal tibia. During the flush, the needle "popped out". The patient picked up and placed on a backboard, secured to the board and loaded into the back of the ambulance for rapid transport to HMH. Base Contact was made with HMH to advise them that Squad 11 was enroute to their facility with a pediatric, 6 year old full arrest, likely drowning, with a 12-15 minute ETA. Both paramedics and FF Paul Webber were present during transport to the hospital in the back of the CARE ambulance providing ALS treatment. During transport, a second IO, 25mm Blue IO was successfully established. The patient was given three rounds of EPI at 0.19mg each dose. The patient continued to be in full arrest/asystole until the CARE ambulance arrived in the ambulance bay of HMH. A pulse check was performed once the ambulance parked in the ambulance bay and the patient had two agonal beats and remained in asystole (i.e. no ROSC achieved). During transport the patient was suctioned several more times due to continuous vomitus in the airway. Transfer of care at approximately 1008 where ED staff continued to work the patient and eventually achieved ROSC (actual ROSC time unknown but estimated by Squad 11 personnel to be at 1030).

Note: The lifeguards at scene stated the patient was "in trouble for approximately 15-20 seconds" before they retrieved/rescued her from the pool. It is unknown how long the patient was pulseless and apneic before by-standard CPR was performed. Upon Squad 11 arrival, the patient was pulseless, apneic, cyanotic fixed and dilated pupils and copious vomitus in the mouth, on her face and on the ground next to her head not in a shockable rhythm.


